








Gender Wise Distribution

Success Story of Yasmeen Bibi

Yasmin Bibi runs a flourishing Livestock business out of 451/EB Burewala, which she had set up a little over three years ago by taking a commercial microfinance loan from AGAHE Pakistan. She supplies fresh milk to the neighbouring community as well as sacrificial animals on festive occasions.

Looking back, she recalls the days when the family was facing very difficult times. With six children and a husband who was working as a contractor, there were many days when he would come home empty handed, and as such, there was no food on the table at times. Their situation was so dire that they didn't even have access to clean drinking water, and Yasmin used to fetch water every day from a neighbour's house. The kids also could not continue with their education due to limited financial means. This is not the type of life she had envisioned, and was keen to lift the family out of poverty.

Her quest for answers led her to AGAHE Pakistan, which sanctioned a loan of 20,000 so she could start her own livestock business. Investing in small animals initially, the herd began to increase over time, and she continued to reinvest in the business. As of today, the herd includes cows, buffaloes, calfs and goats. People from the community regularly visit her home to get fresh cow's milk, averaging 1-15 litres a day, while the animals are traded at popular cattle markets such as Machiwal and Burewala on a weekly basis. To accommodate the herd, she has built a separate shed next to her house, which is managed by a full-time employee from the community. Through this venture, she has brought the family out of absolute poverty, while ensuring that her children's

education continues uninterrupted. Her husband no longer has to work as a contractor, and also takes care of the business.





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
